There will be 13 hangars available, you can use any- **after Junior & U23 competition,** remember you will be sharing it with other participants, please be civilized.

The access to the venue will be done from hangar 0. Main entrance is for public. No boats inside the hangars. All boats must be placed in the exterior racks. For safety you should fix them as wind might be dangerous and make boats fall.

No trailers inside the venue. You need to bring your boats by hand from hangar 1.

Access to the hangars is made from the inside of the venue.

There will be no control or security outside of the venue.

*The competition organization is not responsible for any belongings or equipment you leave behind; the athletes themselves are responsible for this.

LUNCH

Lunch is served at the venue's restaurant between July 29th to 31st, from 11:00 to 14:00.

All athletes that paid the participation fee have lunch included in the 3 days of the championships.

Please bring your accreditation card for all meals. Meals will not be served without accreditation card.

Drinking water will be provided during the whole access period from water dispensers (Clear water system).

TRANSPORTS

COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

ICF rules for the organization of the Masters World Championships will apply.

Reminder of the rules for entries:

Special rules: - there is no limit of boats entered per country in each event

- In all categories there will be 5 year age groups.
- Maximum age group will be 75+ for all categories
- One athlete can only compete in kayak or in Canoe
- One athlete can only compete in one age group inside each category [K1,K2,C1,C2,K4,C4]
- A minimum of 3 boats need to be entered for the category to compete. If less than 3, those entries will be added to the younger age group In Team boats, athletes from different countries may get together. These boats will have no country defined in the entries
- In teams boats the age group is set according to the age of the youngest athlete.
- Each athlete can compete in a maximum of 2 single events and 3 team events. [Events= category + distance]
- All categories competing will be awarded the same medals provided by OC and an official ceremony with anthems will be played. If the winner is a combined country boat, there will be the ICF anthem. Races with less than 3 boats will not have Athens or flags in the ceremony.
- *If you have any questions or misunderstandings, please feel free to ask them before the start of the competition so that no one has any misunderstandings afterwards.

PRE-RACE CONTROL BOAT

Pre-race boat control is a self-boat control.

All athletes are responsible to ensure the boats conform to the technical requirements for the competitions as per the rules. You can find it in hangar 3.

ID CONTROL

The competitors can embark only from the designated place before the competition where their boats, boat numbers and accreditation cards are checked.

In crew boats uniformity will be checked too.

In crew boats there must be uniformity among all athletes including sleeve length, hats, head-bands. If used, spray covers must be the same. Using the spray cover for the first competitor in the crew boat is optional. Glasses are optional.

ITOs will use a computer system to validate all entries. Athletes must present the accreditation card for confirmation of an entry.

You need to take your accreditation card to the ID control. If you don't pass the ID control you will be DSQ from the race.



BOAT NUMBERS

Boat numbers will be given when you pass the ID control. They must be returned to the organisation by leaving them on the proper box, outside the exit pontoons or 2nd boat control.

POST RACE BOAT CONTROL

After the race some boats will be selected by the competition committee for a post-race boat control

A led Screen with the lane numbers selected will be allocated after the finish line on the left-hand side on the ground.

The screen will also present the race name and number.

TRAFFIC RULES DURING RACE DAYS

During the race day athletes are kindly requested to use the Returning channel to go to the start area. There are connection paths at 1100 and 600 meters. This channel can also be used for warming up before the race.

We advise all athletes not to use the returning channel between 1100 and 2000 meters, as it might be found with Water weed.

For cooling down, please use the Channel on the side of the hangars, next to the restaurant area.

CYCLING PATH

The cycling path is located on the north side of the course [opposite to finish tower side. The access is free to all coaches.

The road will not be fully controlled by OC as there are multi entrances along more than 2000 meters, so we advise caution during the use of this road.



CEREMONIES

Please check the schedule for the ceremonies in the general timetable.

*Medal ceremonies will start at their official place and scheduled time without delay.

Make sure you use proper clothes and shoes during the ceremony.

*NO FLAGS, CAPS, SUNGLASSES are allowed on the podium!!!

SAFETY AND RESCUE

OC will provide ambulance and medical service at the venue. Major issues will be allocated to the nearest hospital. Outside venue costs in Hospitals will need to be secured by each participant.

ANTI DOPING

For the International competition each athlete, coach, and support personnel is responsible for knowledge of anti-doping rules and the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their rule.
